The meeting was presided over by Shri Kunal IAS, Deputy Commissioner & Chairman, District Level NLUP Implementing Committee, Saiha. Welcoming the members, chairman apprised them that the meeting was convened in order to deliberate upon the needful preparations for the coming meeting/training to be held at Aizawl on 13.01.2010.

The following points were deliberated upon and decisions taken:-

- District Wise Training Schedule :** Since District Level Training had already been conducted during December 7-12, 2009 and due to exigency of time, the meeting resolved that we are not in a position to conduct District Level Training at this juncture. Hence no schedule is chalked out for the same.
- Recommended Trades/Activities (Village-wise) :** A compilation sheet of various trades/activities opted by the selected beneficiaries was presented and discussed upon at the meeting. The paper indicates that out of 1200 beneficiaries, 957 beneficiaries have made their options. Department-wise break-up of various trades/activities opted by the beneficiaries is as below-

Industries	-	115	beneficiaries (12.02%)
Fisheries	-	53	beneficiaries (05.54%)
AH & Vety	-	525	beneficiaries (54.86%)
Agriculture	-	79	beneficiaries (08.25%)
Sericulture	-	2	beneficiaries (00.21%)
Soil & WC	-	16	beneficiaries (01.67%)

The committee was not happy with the options made so far by the beneficiaries because more than half of them have opted for activities under AH & Vety Deptt alone. Hence emphasis was laid on the need to review the trade selection in such manner as to ensure successful implementation of the NLUP.

In this regards, the following decisions were made-

- (a) During Village Level Trainings, all the selected beneficiaries be interacted with / interviewed by the concerned Village Level Implementing Committee and Line Deptt Officials, on behalf of the District Level Implementing Committee. Final selection of trades/activities will be made in line with their discussions.
  - (b) In rural areas, 10% of the beneficiaries each will be reserved for Industry and AH & Vety Departments.
  - (c) MADC be requested to ensure timely allotment of 2 hectares of land to all the beneficiaries on need base.
  - (c) NLUP Implementing Board be requested to give us additional time for finalizing selection of trades/activities.
3. **Village Level Training Schedule :** Training Schedule prepared by the DC Office was found satisfactory and approved (*Copy enclosed*).
4. The meeting also resolved that some basic amenities/facilities needed by the villages be noted down by the Line Deptt Officials during their visit on Village Level Trainings.
