

**MINUTES OF THE REVIEW MEETING OF VILLAGE LEVEL TRAINING
SCHEDULE ON NLUP HELD IN THE OFFICE CHAMBER OF ADDL.DEPUTY
COMMISSIONER, SAIHA AT 2:00PM ON 18.01.2010**

The meeting was chaired by Pu Thangchem Zathang, Addl.DC, Saiha. Welcoming the members, chairman thanked them for their presence in spite of their busy routine works. He informed the members that the meeting was convened in order to review the Schedule for Village Level NLUP Training, and to deliberate upon every necessary issues in connection with selection of trades/activities by the beneficiaries.

The following points were discussed and resolved upon:-

1. Village Level Training Schedule.

Village Level Training Schedule had already been prepared and approved by District Level Implementing Committee. However, it was resolved in the *Interactive Training for the Successful Implementation of NLUP* held at Agriculture Conference Hall, Aizawl on 13th January, 2010 that final list of trade/activity selection be submitted by each District Level Implementing Committee to the NLUP Implementing Board, Mizoram, Aizawl latest by 18.02.2010. Hence the need for revision of the training schedule in line with this decision was impressed upon.

It was resolved that rural areas be covered by two groups of resource persons (Eastern Group & Western Group) drawn from each line department, and that revised schedule for this purpose be chalked out and issued by DC for compliance.

2. Re-verification of Beneficiaries vis-à-vis Selection of Trades/Activities.

As instructed by the NLUP Implementing Board, the meeting reiterated the importance of systematic orientation/guidance for the beneficiaries in connection with selection of trades/activities. All line department officials are requested and expected to extend careful guidance to the beneficiaries during Village Level Trainings so as to ensure successful implementation of NLUP in Saiha District.

3. Conveyance for Resource Persons.

Unfavourable conditions of roads do not permit Cars and other luxurious vehicles to access the interior parts of the district. This has created problems on conveyance of resource persons who will be deployed for Village Level Trainings throughout the district. Since the District Heads of Line Departments do not have such tough vehicles which will be fit to traverse the far-flung areas, the problem was discussed.

It was decided that two (2) Light Motor Vehicles (LMV's) each will be hired for the two groups of resource persons. DAO and RO(Soil) are requested to explore suitable vehicles for Group-I (Eastern Group), and DHO and DSO are also requested to explore suitable vehicles for Group-II (Western Group).

4. Dearness Allowance to Department Officials.

Since the training programme is an extra normal official duty and due to unavoidable incurrence of some expenditure from private pocket during tour, the meeting resolved to issue Dearness Allowance (DA) to all line Department Officials who tour the district for Village Level Trainings as admissible under rules.
