

Sir,

I am directed to refer to this Ministry's letters of even number dated 13th September, 2010 and 15th October, 2010 intimating that the software has been developed for on-line submission of proposals for release of Central Funds under MGNREGA.

The present form of software would only allow this Ministry to download the proposals from the web but it can only be processed once the signed copy from the District/State is made available to the Ministry. It has therefore, been decided to allow all the Districts and the States/UTs to purchase one digital pad and pen to enable each DPC at the district level and the MGNREGA Commissioner at the State level to put their digital signature on the proposal and the same by the Chartered Accountant and counter signed by DPC on the Audit Report so that Ministry may take instant action on the proposal downloaded from the web. It will further reduce time taken in postal services.



Kindly refer to letter No. K-11015/1/2010-NREGA dated 11th November, 2010 related to purchase of digital pad and pen for online submission of proposal for release of funds under Mahatma Gandhi NREGA.

The present form of software would only allow this Ministry to download the proposals from the web but it can only be processed once the signed copy from the District/State is made available to the Ministry. It has therefore, been decided to allow all the Districts and the States/UTs to purchase digital signature for each DPC at the district level and the MGNREGA Commissioner/ Principal Secretary at the State level who would recommend the proposal to MoRD. The Chartered Accountant will also digitally sign the audit report which will be counter signed by DPC so that Ministry may take instant action on the proposal downloaded from the web. It may please be noted that proposals without digital signature will not be entertained.
